The walking frame is available in several up-to-the-minute colours.



Sporty design, contemporary colours and limited weight are what characterise the high-end walking frame Carbon Ultralight byACRE, which RUSSKA are also bringing with them to Leipzig. It can be used both indoors and outdoors.



Also on display at the RUSSKA stand: the ATTO mobility scooter, which is comfortable and convenient to drive – both at home and when out and about - on account of the seat and handlebar that can both be adjusted for height. When folded, this collapsible electric mobility device can be pulled along like a suitcase on wheels.



Because of its joystick steering, the electric scooter, MovingStar 101, can also be driven right up to the edges of tables. It saves space and is easily transported.
