The Aktiv Genu OA knee brace and the thoracolumbar brace, ErgoSpine pro



Spektramed (Wegberg, Germany) are banking on a flat profile and lightweight construction to ensure the popularity of their new Aktiv Genu OA knee brace. Medial and lateral relief of the knee compartment derives from the three-point pressure relief principle, as well as from physiological control of the knee joint. Other features of the brace, which the company are bringing to OTWorld, include unilateral application, ease of adjustment, thanks to built-in wing screws, and the ability to limit both flexion and extension. Rapid fasteners make it easy to put on and take off the orthosis, which is available in one universal size.



Also new to the Spectramed portfolio is the thoracolumbar orthosis, the ErgoSpine pro, designed to stabilise the spine in both frontal and sagittal planes. Behind this orthosis lies a modular concept, which allows the height, circumference and degree of waist shaping to be altered quickly and easily. The various materials used help to improve both comfort when worn and anatomical fit. The orthosis covers spinal regions S1 to TH5.
